 - **Entries must be made on-line at www.equestrianentries.co.nz. You will receive an emailed response giving your entry details, fees owing and bank a/c no. for internet banking.**
 - **Entry Fees must be made at time of entry or entries will not be accepted.**

 - All riders must be a member of ESNZ

 - Refunds: After closing date, requests for refunds of Entry Fees must be in writing, accompanied by a Medical or Vet Certificate within one month after tournament date. (20% of entry fee plus \$25 ground/admin fee will be retained.) All other requests will be presented to the Committee who MAY use their discretion
 - Competitors restricted to 3 tests per horse/pony per a day
 - **NON COMPETING HORSES:** Permission to have any NON Competing horse/ponies on the grounds needs to be requested from the Show Secretary (only) AND must be done at least 3 days prior to the tournament. Not all tournaments are appropriate for this due to entry numbers etc.
 - Please leave stables and areas around floats/trucks clean and tidy. All manure and hay to be removed from grounds by competitors or left in the designated areas.
 - All dogs must be on a lead at all times from the time they enter the showgrounds.
 - All riders must wear a current **tagged** NZ Safety standards approved helmet
- Competition Conditions for Para Classes**
- Event run under ESNZ PE, DNZ & ESNZ rules & regulations. All terms and conditions in the entire schedule apply.
 - Please specify TOC when entering
 - All riders and horses must be financial members of ESNZ
 - All riders must have an FEI or ESNZ classification card and it must be available at all times while riding at the event.
 - ESNZ PE rules regarding sharing of horses apply and no horse may be shared between a/b & pe riders as per article 474 DNZ rules
 - Please state in stabling requests any special requests (in regard to a suitable stabling location etc) and the OC will try their best to accommodate where possible.

Hanoverian Award

Two Sashes are being awarded for overall highest scoring horse registered with the NZHS in Level 1-3 and Level 4 and above (must be Champion or Reserve)

AMS Pony & Young Rider Performance League (for full details refer to NZEF website)

Eligibility

1. Downgraded horses/ponies may only compete in their original grade (refer DG rules eff 1 Aug 2017)
2. Competitors must be 20 years or under at 1 August 2017
3. All competitors of the correct age entered in AMS Pony and Young Rider classes levels 1 -2 at a Regional and Island Event are eligible
4. All competitors of the correct age entered in Super 5 classes at levels 3 - 9 at Regional Events, the South Island Festival of Dressage and North Island Champs are eligible.
5. All competitors of the correct age entered at the Samsung/GLT Networks NZ Pony & Young Rider Championships are eligible.

Futurity Stakes for the Sanoussie Trophy, horses to be nominated by 3 November 2017 enclosing \$10 nomination fee or pay \$30 in total if entering as at March Tournament. Open to Level 1 & 2 horses and ponies as at 3 November 2017.

Rosettes down to tenth/Prize Money to 6th, Competition will be finalised with a Level 2 Test at the March Tournament.

Horses upgrading during the season are still eligible to compete. Test may be called.

TRAINING CLASSES

- **Please refer to the conditions above plus the following which is just relevant to the training classes:**
- All riders must be a member of ESNZ
- **Rider/Horses combinations that have been registered Level 3 or above at any time are not eligible for any classes.**
- **Beginner Classes:** These classes are for riders/horse or pony combinations that are new to the competition atmosphere. If you show jump, event or show at A & Ps where you canter then these classes are not the classes for you. Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- **All Category 4 riders and above in any unregistered class are not eligible for prizes but are able to ride HC**
- Plaiting/Jackets optional – Pony Club uniform or tidy attire acceptable
- Entry Fee \$10 per class unless otherwise stated
- Prizes – Rosettes to 4th place.
- Ground/Administration \$25 per horse/pony.
