Format of the Competition

40 horses / ponies plus 5 reserves will be named across the 5 sections except that Dressage NZ reserves the right not to offer all 5 sections dependent on nominations received.

Nominations Close Date: 3rd October 2017 on Equestrian Entries. No nomination fee required. Acceptances and reserve list will be notified by 1st November.

Eligibility:

1. Combinations must have competed at the Level nominated between 1 October 2016 and 1st October 2017 and be able to demonstrate a minimum of two scores at the level nominated. Grading points and all eligibility restrictions **as at date of close of nomination**
2. All riders must be current full ESNZ members at date of nomination
3. All horses and ponies must have a current annual start for Dressage

Rider Age:

1. **Youth:** Riders from beginning of calendar year in which rider turns 12yrs until end of calendar year in which they reach 16yrs
2. **Seniors:** From beginning of calendar year in which a rider turns 16 years Ponies may be ridden in all sections

FEI Children Team Competition Test ED 2016.
- 2 **SENIOR I CLASS** (NZL Level 3/4) Senior Riders only
FEI Children Individual Competition Test ED 2014 UPDATED 2016
Horses / ponies may not have Level 5 or above pts at 3/10/17
- 3 **HATTON & LILLY SENIOR II CLASS** (NZL Level 5) Senior Riders only
FEI Junior Team Competition Test ED 2009 Updated 2017.
Horses/ponies may not have 30 or more pts in Level 6 or above at 3/10/17
- 4 **SYNCROFLEX PRIX ST GEORGES: ED 2017** Senior Riders only. Open to all Advanced Level horses, except that horses with more than 30 Level 7 or above pts at 3/10/17 may only be ridden by riders C7 or below
- 5 **LIVAMOL INTERMEDIATE I: ED 2017** Senior Riders only. Open to all Advanced level horses except those with more than 30 Level 8pts or any Level 9 points at 3/10/17 may only be ridden by riders C7 or below.

All Fees will be payable within 5 days of acceptance notification (1st November). No prize money. Winners rugs, rosettes for all competitors. All Classes \$150.00 per horse. Includes on site medics fee of \$25. Camping and stabling fees additional and will be advised with selection notification. Payment and entry details will be co-ordinated with Canterbury Championships, details will be notified with selection notification
