General Information

- No plaiting required, tidy attire please (no formal jackets, etc)
- Helmets must be red tagged and appropriate riding footwear is needed
- All competition and warm up will be on the surface
- Back numbers must be worn (supplied ones to be returned) and the use of ID tags when not ridden is strongly encouraged (we will have some tags available for purchase at the office for \$5 each)
- First entered gets preferred time slot
- Equestrian Entries is NOT being used for this training and fun day; all entries must be emailed to southlanddressage@gmail.com and paid at time of entry (or will not be accepted)

- No printed catalogues will be available
- No lead rein class for Prix Caprilli due to safety considerations
- Prizes for the Recycled Ribbon competitions will be awarded at the completion of the competition (arrangements will be made to get the prizes to you if you need to leave)
- Time slots used so you can come, ride and then head off when finished (but you're welcome to stay and socialise too!)

Health & Safety

Dressage Southland takes Health and Safety very seriously. Currently, Corona virus (Covid-19) is very much a subject on people's minds at the moment. Along with our usual stringent Health & Safety procedures, Dressage Southland will be following ESNZ, DNZ, Ministry of Health and governmental directives in any decision making. We will endeavour to inform people of any changes as soon as possible.

There will be plenty of paper towels and liquid soap in the two main toilet blocks, please do wash your hands frequently (remember the 20 second rule) and dispose of the paper towels in the bins. Please let a committee member know if towels or soap need replenishing or if bins need to be emptied.

Please do bring your own hand wash and/or sanitiser for use at your vehicle.

Please do not share food or drinks with others outside of your family group.

If you are unwell, please do not attend this event.

Helpful tips

Parking

Please enter via the south entrance off Salford Street. 4WD towing vehicles and floats are ok to park in the yard paddock but please choose your spot wisely as the grounds may be a little soft in patches.

Non-4WD towing vehicles and floats are strongly encouraged to park on a gravelled surface.

It would be appreciated if trucks could park on a gravelled surface with all wheels on the gravel.

Parking in front of the covered yards: It is recommended that the space in front of the covered yards is used for trucks, but if you have a covered yard and use a float, you can park there too. All vehicles must park on the right-hand side of the gravelled accessway (facing north - towards the oval), and nose to tail please. This will allow for a safe passageway for vehicles and horses directly in front of the covered yards. Any changes to this will be advised by the Parking Manager. As part of this, we would appreciate if you could directly supervise your horse/pony if it is tied to your vehicle when on the gravelled surface.

If your horse/pony is tied to a float, the float must have a vehicle attached.

If you plan on leaving early in the day, it would be best if you parked in the yard area as, for courtesy and safety reasons, we encourage people to only leave from the gravelled areas during breaks in competition.

Tyler McKee is the Parking and Stable Manager and will be available to help/direct you. If you need to contact him urgently, his number is 027 235 5150.

Yards and stables

If you haven't booked a yard, there are still some available and we would encourage you to use these to help protect the grounds. If you do use a yard and haven't already booked one, please let someone at the office know and pay \$10. Yards are not designated, you can choose your own. Please do not use the yards closest to the west toilet block in the yard paddock as they belong to the Southland show jumping group. Please make sure that all stables and yards are left clean and tidy. If you notice any damage or other issues, please let the office know. There are a few wheelbarrows on the grounds for general use. Please use the designated manure deposit areas. Do not add sawdust to the outside yards.

General

If you need the First Aid officer, please report to the Office. If it is an emergency situation, please dial 111. There will be no ambulance on site.

If you need to scratch, please advise the Event Secretary (Sonja Swale: southlanddressage@gmail.com or 0274440497) as soon as possible. Either a medical certificate or veterinary certificate will need to be produced should you wish to claim a refund. \$10 of your entry will be retained for administration purposes

PRIX CAPRILLI TESTS

A Prix Caprilli, named after the great Italian rider who was the father of the modern forward seat for jumping, is a dressage test with jumps included.

The tests have the same movements as a preliminary/novice dressage test and include the requirement for horse and rider to trot and/or canter over single jumps.

The judges will judge this test the same as a normal dressage test that includes technical marks for the movement, impulsion, submission and riding.

The emphasis is not the jumping style of the horse, it is on the horse's relaxation, obedience and evenness of pace.

It is a dressage test that happens to have jumps in the way and the jumps should not disrupt the standard performance expected in a dressage test.

It is worth thinking about the riding style you will adopt over the jumps as you will need to establish a position over the jumps that assists the horse in freely jumping over the jump without any resistance.

Practice at home in your own dressage arena before the day. It's something different to the normal dressage test and a bit of fun. Why not have a go!

This test is an encouragement test and there for the trotting / canter stage is optional to the rider but you will get scored higher in the canter than trot for giving it a go.

Let the judge know what option you take before the test so they can mark you correctly.
